*Muslim Aid launched a Boys School Project in Kahori, Muzafarabad*

Muslim Aid keep continuing the rehabilitation process of Kashmir's 8th October earthquake aftermath and fulfilling the promise to rebuild a Boys High School of village Kahori (ten kilometers a head from Muzafarabad). This is a joint project by Muslim Aid and National Volunteer Movement. The Layout Plan and structural design of the school has been approved by NESPAK as per Seismic Resistant code. Muslim Aid has appointed Pak-UK Associates as the contractors for the construction of the project; they have started the excavation work.

*Inauguration of Muslim Aid Computer and Science Lab in Huda Public School, Khushab.*

Muslim Aid selected a school from the most deprived, neglected and poor village Peelovence of Khushab District for the enhancement of quality and high standard education. The project was carried out in Peelovence, the most deprived place of Khushab. Due to scarcity of resources the people of the village cannot acquire quality education. The project was handed over to the

Huda Public school who will run and responsible for the execution of both Labs. A management committee comprising of Muslim Aid representative, School representative and educationist will monitor the activities of the Labs.



EDO Literacy Khushab District Mr. Sarfraz Chatha and EDO Education Dr. Umer Farooq inaugurated the Muslim Aid Computer and Science Lab in Huda Model Public School, Village Peelovence (District Khushab). Principal Abdullah Jasra, staff and students with their parents appreciated Muslim Aid donation of Computer and Science Labs worth of 1 million rupees. On this occasion a lot of prominent educationists, dignities, huge numbers of people from surrounding villages and the parents of the students were also present. Everybody was so happy to receive a computer and science labs in their school because nobody from any development sector or government came there before or did any kind of development project in their area. Al-Khidmat Diagnostic Lab, Chitral*

Muslim Aid in collaboration with Al-Khidmat Foundation NWFP established a state of the art Diagnostic Lab in Chitral. The Lab will provide the

diagnostic facilities, which are even not available in Government hospitals. This project is costing 4.2 million rupees. Al-Khidmat foundation is responsible for the day to day operation of the Lab. A Management committee comprised of representatives of Muslim Aid, Al-Khidmat and doctors will overall supervise the activities of the lab. Niamatullah Khan, President Al-Khidmat Foundation Pakistan and Maghfirat Shah, District Nazim Chitral inaugurated the centre on 9th December 2007. Syed Moez Program Manager Muslim Aid and Haji Shakirullah, Director Al-Khidmat NWFP were also present on the occasion. The centre is equipped with state of the art medical equipments. It will provide a big relief to the people of Chitral, who will get diagnostic services under one roof.
