

Muslim Aid provides medical aid to Attaabad lake affectees



Gilgit June, 4: Muslim Aid, a UK based relief and development agency has set up dispensary and medical camps in Danyore for Hunza landslide affected people here on Friday.

A medical team is deployed with necessary items in Danyore, Muslim Aid official informed. He said that the organisation has dispatched essential life-saving drugs to the affected area. Our doctors with essential medicines are working in Gilgit in collaboration with district government.

Muslim Aid Health Coordinator Dr. Wajid said that we in contact with National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Govt. agencies and NGOs for providing medical aid for the alluring masses of Attaabad lake affectees. Muslim Aid has pronged a strategy to provide relief if Attaabad Lake outflows. We are also in contact with the camps management established for IDPs in different areas of Gilgit.

While informing, he further said that the case of malnutrition, anemic, scabies, eczema, typhoid are being treated by a team of Muslim Aid doctors. We treat 80 to 100 patients daily and provide them life-saving drugs free of cost.
